- **Team Roster:** Changes to the official team roster (7 members) allowed up until the start of the Coaches Meeting to allow for time to update scoring program and score sheets.
- **Team Entry:** Seven (7) players, One (1) scorekeeper and Two (2) coaches.
- **Individual Entry:** Two (2) coaches, per school with 1 or more individual bowlers.
- Lower bowling area limited to those listed on the official team roster.
- **Note:** League commissioners will be provided a scoring spread sheet with instructions for the league tournament. After the tournament, **league commissioners** will submit scoring sheets and results to **Justin Brien** ASAP. This will help make it easier to populate district scoring program, score sheets, and tournament program.

ALTERNATES

Individual bowlers failing to check-in by the start of the Coaches meeting (7:45 a.m./2:15 p.m.), we will look to replace the individual in the following order.

- A. Highest Qualifying Alternate from the same league as the missing bowler.
- B. Highest Season Average from the same classification from another league.

Note: Individual bowlers must be checked-in prior to the start of the coaches meeting. Alternate bowlers will fill the vacant spots at the coaches meeting.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- **No Outside Food or Drink Allowed (Including outside coffee)**
- **Warm-up** Fifteen (15) minutes allowed prior to the start of Round One (1).
- **Team Introductions:** Introductions will take place prior to Round One (1).
- **Uniform:** All players and coaches shall appear in appropriate matching tops and matched colored bottoms for their school bowling uniform. All team members must be similarly dressed. Slacks, hemmed shorts, skirts and collared sport shirts with a commercially lettered school name and logo on the back are acceptable team apparel. ***Athletes may not compete in jeans or yoga pants.*** Individual names allowed on the front of the shirt only. No Hats allowed.
- **Conduct of Coaches and Players:** The head coach shall be the official team representative for all communications with tournament officials. Only two coaches and qualified team members allowed in the team seating or lane playing area (or one coach and scorekeeper). The total number shall not exceed seven per team.
- **Tie Procedure:** If two or more individuals tie for eliminating position, they will bowl 9th and 10th frame roll-off. In the event of a tie for an individual alternate, the bowler with the higher league average will win the tie. **Must be present for the roll-off frame or will forfeit the position.**
- **Open Substitutions:** Open substitutions allowed at any time during a regular game. If a substitute enters in the middle of a game, the substitute must assume the score of the competitor she is replacing. The score will not be assigned to anyone and the original competitor cannot re-enter that game. All substitutions must be noted on the scorecard. The same substitution rule applies to the Baker games.
- Official school banner (made of cloth or vinyl) will be the only sign permitted. Loud cheering and chanting should be kept at a minimum
- Artificial noise-makers or balloons are prohibited
- Cheerleader or student/parent led chants not allowed
- Electronic devices **NOT** allowed in the bowling area
- Ball Information:
 - Removing the ball from the establishment during the competition prohibited.
 - Use of abrasives between Round One (1) and Round Two (2) is prohibited.
 - Cleaning agents are not allowed. Towels are allowed.
 - Coaches are responsible to ensure that all team member's balls will conform to USBC specifications.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Round 1: Five girls bowl three (3) games of total pins. Teams will rotate lanes after each game. Individual State qualifying scores require the individual to bowl **ALL** games in Round One (1).
- Round 2: Baker Format:
- Teams will be paired by results of Round One (1)
 - 1-2, 3-4, 4-6, etc.
 - All five (5) team members follow each other in regular order to bowl a single game. Player #1 bowls frames 1 and 6, #2 bowls frames 2 and 7, #3 bowls frames 3 and 8, #4 bowls frames 4 and 9, and #5 bowls frames 5 and 10.

- The coach determines the bowling order and can adjust the order at the end of any game. The combined effort of the team constitutes a game.

OFFICIAL SCORE: The head coach is responsible for verifying and submitting the official score sheet. Only coaches or official scorekeeper allowed in the official scoring area.

- Pin total after the Four (4) games of Baker Format combined with the Round One (1) totals to determine the top teams qualifying to state.
- **Tie Procedure:** Round One (1): A coin flip will determine lane placement after Round One (1). If two or more teams tie for the last qualifying place for state, the teams involved will bowl full baker game.

- Spectators are not allowed in the lower seating or lane playing area.
- No outside food or drink (including coffee)
- NO smoking
- NO alcohol
